A manually operated powerhouse of productivity, binding documents with a spine width of up to 54mm. In addition, you can choose to bind documents in a variety of formats, such as A5, B5, A4, A3 and printouts measuring up to 370 mm in length. The Bindomatic 5000 can be successfully used on its own, or as a complement to our larger, automatic binders.

The smallest of these, the Bindomatic 101 DFS, is fast and simple to use and binds up to 1,600 documents per hour.
